### Safeguarding and Child Protection

### Evacuation Points

To ensure safe evacuation from the building please follow the illuminated exit signs and make your way to the designated assembly points on the Paget Road car park and playground site and Clark Road designated area.



Any classes/visitors in the Hall, please leave by the nearest exit point.

If the location of the fire or incident prevents escape by the designated route, staff should choose the next safest route available. (please see evacuation procedures for further information)
