Late Collection Policy:

The normal school day operates between the hours of 8.50am to 3.20pm for EYFS and Key Stage 1, 8.50am to 3.25pm for Key Stage 2. Enrichment clubs operate between the hours of 3.45pm and 4.45pm. School After care operates between the hours of 3.20pm to 5.45pm.
