

This term we will be helping the children to settle into our Reception routines. We will be having lots of fun exploring our inside and outside environment. In Maths we will be investigating number by counting, matching numerals to quantities, and counting objects reliably. In our shape, space and measure work, we will be finding out about shapes and patterns all around us. We will also be using the measurement of length and explore positional language.

For our Understanding the World focus, we will be sharing information about ourselves and our families. Then we will be investigating materials to find out which would make a good waterproof hat and to see which materials float and sink.
