Curriculum

We want to take this opportunity to welcome back our older members of Terrific for Twos and nursery and the children who will be joining us.

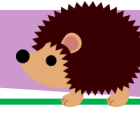
For the next couple of weeks we will be settling your child back into their daily school routine. We will be supporting the children to:



- ⇒ using equipment safely
- ⇒ Share
- ⇒ Take turns
- ⇒ encouraging friendships.
- ⇒ Positive behavior
- ⇒ Playing outdoors as well as indoors

Within the setting, we will be celebrating children's achievements at home as well as school. We look forward to hearing about what makes you proud of your child.

We do have a wow board within Terrific for Twos and nursery and if your child has done something amazing at home or at school we will then write it down and stick it on our wow board, which then will get stuck into their learning journal showing their development, progress and achievements.



Communication & Language

Within Terrific for Twos and the nursery provision, we will be supporting your child to create friendships, follow instructions and routines and sharing with others. We will support the children to demonstrate an understanding in many ways such as responding to and asking questions. Children will be encouraged to express their language and extend it by explaining.

Literacy

Within the setting we will be looking at different books supporting our topic 'all about me and Autumn'. We will be encouraging your child to use books appropriately such as holding them the correct way or turning individual pages. We will be encouraging your child to share their favourite books with their friends.

Children will be encouraged to mark make in different ways such as chalking, paint, water and sand.

Mathematics

This term we will be looking at numbers, counting one to ten and understanding what numbers are. We will encourage the children to touch count when counting objects to help them recognise objects in set groups. We will be looking at numerals and singing lots of number rhymes. We will also explore space, shape and measure by using various building materials and learn or develop their knowledge of shapes.

Some of the books we will be looking at:

- ⇒ Peace at Last
- ⇒ That's not my hedgehog
- ⇒ Squash and a squeeze
- ⇒ We're going on a bear hunt



Physical development

This term children will be taking part in PE on a Tuesday. Children will take part in different activities or shown different skills which will be developed within the term.

In the classroom, there is a finger gym which is changed regularly. Children will be taking part in tumble tots, dough disco and yoga. Children are supported when going to the toilet and encouraged to help with their own self care, such as pulling their own trousers up or putting their own coat on. As well as this children will be supported within the setting with toilet training.

Understanding the World

We will be exploring the season Autumn by taking part in nature walks. We will be looking at the changes in the Autumn such as leaves falling off the trees and develop the children's knowledge around different animals. We will also be using a wide range of technology such as laptops, beebots, cameras and Ipads. Children will be supported to use this equipment to support their own learning and development.

We will also be learning about celebrations and traditions such as Christmas.
