
NON-LIVING Children will be using their scientific enquiry skills to discover what animals and plants need to survive. They will learn about how animals are suited to different habitats. What do animals, and plants need to survive? As part of our science curriculum the children will have opportunities to complete a range of investigations in our project- 'Awe and Wonder'.

In Geography the children will go on a journey around the world, learning about their local area, the countries that make up the United Kingdom. They will uses atlases and map skills to locate the continents in the world and the oceans that surround them. Following this they will learn about the different homes and animals around the world and how those animals have adapted to their climate.


R.E is going to develop children's knowledge and understanding of the Christian Calendar. How do Christians celebrate the different festivals throughout the Christian Calendar?


