Literacy

Numeracy

In Numeracy will be working on all aspects of mathematics, including number, addition and subtraction, multiplication and division and fractions. It is important that your child continues to practise recalling multiplication facts as they must know these by the end of this year.

In our Science topic, Year 4 will be studying States of Matter. We will be investigating solids, liquids and gases. Children will be learning how they can change the state of water and the water cycle. We will also be learning about Electricity and electrical safety. We will have the opportunity to build our own circuits to test switches, insulators and conductors.

In Computing we will be focusing on E-Safety. We will be learning how to use a search engine, how to create a safe online account and how to be a responsible digital citizen.







