
Our journey through Autumn Term looks very exciting in Year 6!

During Literacy the children will focus on two main texts across the term. These will be Goodnight Mr Tom and Journey to the River Sea. Children will complete a range of text types, both fiction and non-fiction, as well as focusing on a range of grammar and

punctuation outcomes.

Numeracy

In Numeracy pupils will cover a range of mathematical topics, with the aim of consolidating their understanding of place value and the written methods, before moving onto fractions, decimals and percentages. Pupils will have the chance to solve multi-step problems whilst also aiming to reason and explain their findings.

Science

During Science this term we will learn about animal and plant classification, where children will have the opportunity to study a key individual-Carl Linnaeus. Pupils will then move onto studying the human body and healthy lifestyles. They will be given the opportunity to complete scientific enquiries throughout the term.

This term the children will complete a module of work around spreadsheets, inputting and using data in context. They will then move on to producing their own short film encompassing everything that they have learnt to present to the rest of the school.


