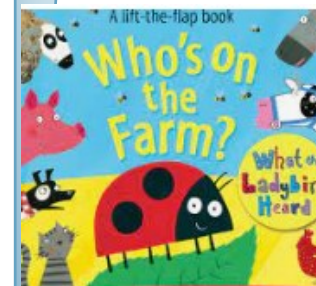

Curriculum

Summer term fun

During the summer term we will be exploring a variety of exciting topics, We will be learning about floating and sinking and explore a variety of materials.

This will be followed by our farm topic where we will read 'Who's On The Farm?', 'Mrs. Wishy Washy's Farm', and 'One Duck Stuck.'

Following our half term break we will be talking about people that help us and how we can help others.

We use a range of Interactive websites for children and parents to access from home and within school.: Marvellous Me- to send parents messages. Bug Club- where you can access reading books for your child. See-saw- - to send homework or parents can send in pictures of their child. Education City- interactive educational activities and games

Communication, Language and Literacy

This term we will be focusing on our mark making and writing, forming our letters, writing our names and talking about our work. We will be joining in with stories, exploring a range of stories, poems and songs, writing letters in our post office and prescriptions in our doctors surgery.

Mathematics

This term we will be looking at numbers by going on number hunts, ordering, counting, estimating and problem solving. We will explore space, shape and measure by using money in the post office, building with blocks and learning the names of shapes.



Understanding the World

We celebrate upcoming celebrations such as Fathers' Day, the Queen's Jubilee and a pirate party. We will be exploring changes in the environment, talking about the weather and what we can see in our nature area.

We will also be using a wide range of technology such as fizz books, BeeBots and the interactive white board.

Physical development

During this term we will participate in sports day, taking turns, joining in with races, completing assault courses and following instructions.

We will continue to develop our fine motor skills through a range of finger gym activities such as threading, using tweezers and manipulating play dough.

Expressive Art and Design

We will be painting pictures of farm animals, making our own fire engine and making items using junk modelling materials.

We welcome our new starters, supporting them as they settle into nursery. We will be starting to manage our conflicts by sharing with others, problem solving and thinking of others needs.

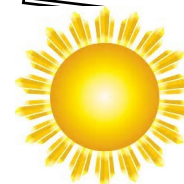
