# Curriculum

We want to take this opportunity to welcome back our older members of Nursery and welcome the children who will be joining us.

For the next couple of weeks we will be settling your child back into their daily school routine. We will be supporting the children to:

- ⇒ Develop friendships
- ⇒ Sharing
- ⇒ Take turns
- ⇒ Try new activities
- ⇒ Show positive behavior
- ⇒ Explore outdoors as well as indoors



Within the setting, we will be celebrating children's achievements at home as well as school.

We will be sending out proud clouds for you to return— we look forward to hearing about what makes you proud of your child.

## Communication & Language

In Nursery, we will be supporting your child to create friendships, to follow instructions and routines and to share with others. We will support the children to demonstrate an understanding in many ways such as responding to and asking questions. To understand 'why' questions. Children will be encouraged to pay attention to more than one thing at a time

### Literacy

Within the setting we will be looking at different books supporting our topics 'All About Me and 'Autumn'. We will be encouraging your child to use books appropriately such as holding them the correct way or turning individual pages. We will be encouraging your child to share their favourite books with their friends.

Children will be exploring how to mark make in different ways such as: chalking, painting and using water and sand.

### Some of the books we will be looking at:

- ⇒ A Squash and a Squeeze
- ⇒ We're Going on a Bear Hunt
- ⇒ My Parents Make me Laugh

## Mathematics

This term we will be looking at numbers, counting one to ten and understanding what numbers are. We will encourage the children to touch count when counting objects to help them recognise objects in set groups. We will be looking at numerals and singing lots of number rhymes. We will also explore space, shape and measure by using various building materials and learn or develop their knowledge of shapes.

## Physical Development

This term, children will be taking part in PE on a **Friday**.

Children will take part in different activities or shown different skills which will be developed within the term.

In Nursery, there is a finger gym area which is changed regularly. Children will be taking part in movement activities, dough disco and outdoor games such as football and riding bikes.

## Understanding the World

We will be exploring the season Autumn by taking part in nature walks. We will be looking at the changes in the Autumn such as leaves falling from the trees and develop the children's knowledge around different animals.

We will also be using a wide range of technology such as laptops, BeeBots, cameras, headphones and iPads.

Children will be supported to use this equipment to support their own learning and development.

We will also be learning about celebrations and traditions such as Bonfire night, Diwali and Christmas.

During the Autumn months could parents please provide a coat due to going outside every day.

Please ensure your child has suitable footwear and clothing that is labelled with their name.
