
# Our journey through Spring term looks very exciting in Year !!

# Well Being

This term we are going to be looking at 'Dreams and Goals' where children will get the chance to discuss what they want to achieve in Year I. Then we will be looking at 'Healthy me' where children will get to think about how we can keep our bodies healthy.



This term in Geography we will be developing our map skills and our knowledge of the world. We will be looking at the UK and the countries that make up the UK. We will be locating the 7 continents and the oceans that surround them while we find popular toys that come from each continent.



# Literacy

As part of Literacy this term we will be writing a set of instructions that our peers will then follow. We will be building on our writing skills to produce a range of different sentence types to suit different genres of writing, including traditional stories and poetry. We will also continue to practice our phonics to prepare us for our phonics screening in June.



During Science this term we will be learning about our bodies. We will be completing different experiments to test our senses. We will be looking at what is inside our bodies and what each organs function is. We will also be looking at plants, where we will conduct our own experiment to see what conditions are needed for a plant to grow successfully.

#### R.E

During R.E this term we will be looking at the Sikh faith. We will be focusing on stories that are remembered, like the story of Guru Nanak and Duni Chand. We will also be looking at Christianity over the Easter period and explore what Easter means to Christians.

# Computing

We will start the Spring term off by learning how to stay safe when we are using the internet. We will then look at grouping and sorting activities and complete a Lego project.

### Numeracy

During Numeracy this term we will continue to read and write numbers in numerals and in words. We will use visual and mental methods to solve addition and subtraction calculations as well as draw on knowledge of place value. We will practise our number bonds regularly so that we can recite them quickly and confidently. We will also be looking at finding 1/2 of shapes and amounts.


During Art this term we will be looking at

completing observational and abstract art.


