
Literacy

In Literacy, Year 4 will be starting this term with The Wizard of Oz by L. Frank Baum. We will also be reading the text Sam Wu is Not Afraid of the Dark. In Spring 2, we will be reading Cloud Busting, Non-fiction texts that relate to our topic of the Industrial Revolution and Rudyard Kipling: 'Just So' Stories! We will be writing for a range of different purposes.

Science

In our Science topic, Year 4 will be studying Sound. We will be investigating: What is sound?, How do our ears work? And What is the difference between Pitch and Volume?

In addition to this, Living things and their habitats will be covered. Areas such as the animal groups,


Numeracy

In Numeracy will be working on all aspects of mathematics, including number, addition and subtraction, multiplication and division and fractions. It is important that your child continues to practise recalling multiplication facts as they must know these by the end of this year.

In Art, we will be focusing on an artist called Georgia O'Keeffe. We will be exploring her artwork and using her work to inspire us to create artwork in her style.

In DT, our topic is juggling balls. We will design, create and test and investigate whether weight alters the performance of a juggling ball.



Reading

All children are provided with a school reading book and reading record. We expect both of these to be in school every day. This is so we can hear the children read both individually and through guided reading sessions. Children are encouraged to read as much as possible and we would ask that they are heard at home so they develop a love of reading.

Computing

In Computing we will be focusing on Computer skills. We will be learning how to use different functions on Microsoft word. In addition, children will learn about animation and how this has developed over many years.
