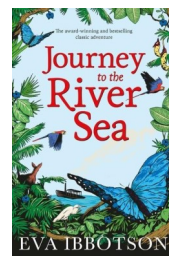
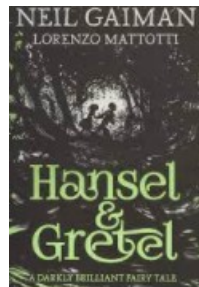


Our journey through Spring Term looks very exciting in Year 6!

Literacy

This term we will be reading a range of texts including Voices in the Park, Journey to the River Sea, Macbeth, and history related non-fiction texts. Pupils will write for a range of purposes including Entertain, Inform, Persuade and Discuss. The study of Shakespeare's Macbeth will also incorporate drama.

Numeracy

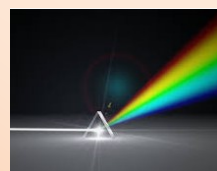
In Numeracy, pupils will cover a range of mathematical topics, with the aim of consolidating their understanding of place value and the written methods, before moving onto fractions, decimals and percentages. Pupils will have the chance to solve multi-step problems whilst also aiming to reason and explain their findings.



Science

During Science this term we will focus on 'Light' and 'Electricity'. Our topics will cover a range of enquiry questions such as 'what colour do you get if you mix different colours together?' and 'can we change the traditional components of a circuit?'

Our Electricity topic will also link to Design and Technology, where we will be making robots!

Well-Being

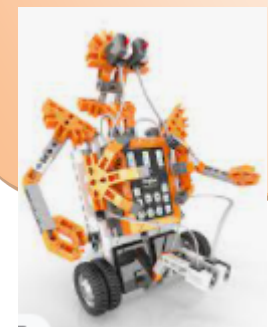
In Well-Being this term, pupils will be exploring their health; both physical and mental. They will identify strategies that can be used to improve and maintain a healthy lifestyle.

In History, we will be studying Crime and Punishment in London through the years. Time periods will include Romans, Anglo-Saxons, Vikings, Early Modern Day Period and the Victorian Age. Pupils will study the use of jury, judges, lawyers and trial evidence.

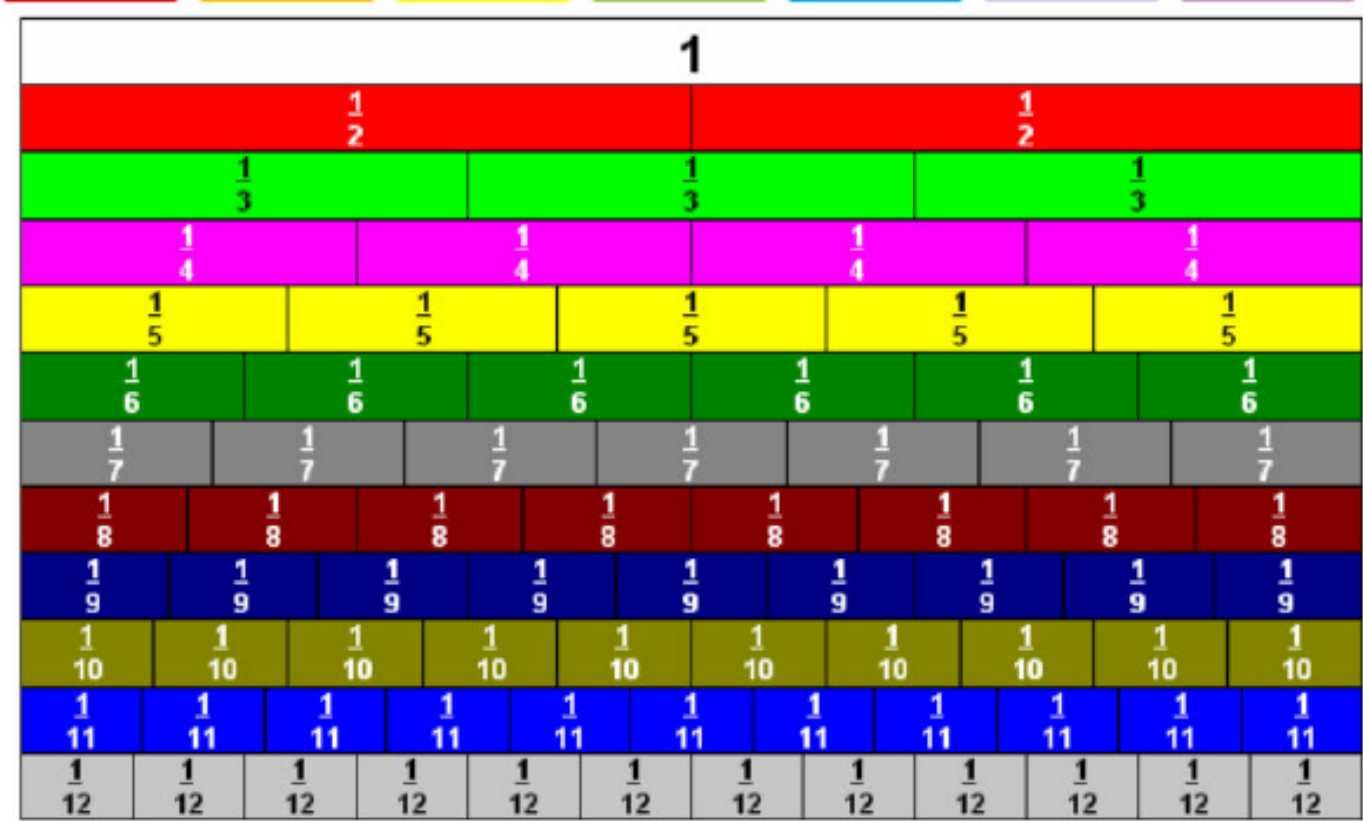
