


Literacy

We will be looking at stories like 'Where The Wild Things Are' and 'My Large in Charge'. We will also continue to practice our phonics to prepare us for our phonics screening in June.

Numeracy

During Numeracy this term we will continue to read and write numbers in numerals and in words. We will develop our knowledge of place value and solve addition and subtraction calculations. We will continue to think about the 2, 5 and 10 times tables and use this to help us solve multiplication and division problems. We will practise our number bonds regularly so that we can recite them quickly and confidently. We will also be looking at capacity, weight and time.



Topic

This term in Geography we will be exploring animals around the world and why different animals are suited to where they live. We will be finding out about the 7 continents and the 5 different oceans around the world. As part of History we will be looking what it was like for our grandparents as children- Asking questions about their school days and how things have changed over time.

Science

During Science this term we will be learning about Marvellous Materials. We will be exploring different properties of materials and why they are best suited for different objects. We will also be looking at magnetic and non-magnetic materials and sorting objects by their properties.



Art /D.T

During Art this term we will be looking at Henri Matisse.

We will be using a range of materials to develop our techniques using texture, colour, form and space

Throughout D.T we will be exploring materials to design and make a suitable boat to float which will be linked to our work in Science.



R.E

During R.E this term we will be looking at Sikhism and their Holy building called the Gurdawara. We will be thinking about why this is a special place for Sikhs, as well as looking at the important features of the building. We will also be thinking about the meaning of creation and recalling the Christian creation story.




Computing
