Welcome to Summer Term in Terrific for Twos




This term we say goodbye to some of our children as they move up to nursery and welcome our new starters

Communication, Language and Literacy

In Summer term, we introduce our new topic—People That Help Us - exploring both fiction and non fiction texts about each profession.

Physical Development
