Curriculum

We want to take this opportunity to welcome back our older members of Terrific for Twos and welcome the children who will be joining us.

For the next couple of weeks we will be settling your child into their daily school routine. We will be supporting the children to:

- ⇒ Develop friendships
- \Rightarrow Share equipment
- \Rightarrow Take turns
- \Rightarrow Try new activities
- ⇒ Explore outdoors as well as indoors
- ⇒ Develop independence

Person, Social and Emotional development

As we settle into our new routine we will be learning about our new environment and developing our class rules, we will be developing our own ideas as we learn through play, exploring each activity and making independent choices.

We will be building friendships and learning social skills such as sharing and listening to others, we will also be learning about our emotions and how to express our feelings.





Communication & Language

Within Terrific for Twos provision, we will be supporting each child to settle into Twos, create friendships, follow instructions and routines and share with others.

We will be listening to many stories and learning lots of songs and nursery rhymes—listen out for them at home!

We will be learning basic Makaton signs and learning new vocabulary through circle time and our experiences and activities.

Literacy Within the setting we will be looking at different books supporting our topic 'All About Me and 'Autumn'. We will learn to use books appropriately, holding them the correct way or turning individual pages, talking about the pictures. We will be sharing our favourite books with friends and joining in with circle time.

We will be exploring how to mark make in different ways such as chalking, paint, water and sand

Some of the books we will be looking at:

- ⇒ That's Not My Hedgehog
- ⇒ We're Going on a Leaf Hunt
- ⇒ My Parents Make me Laugh

Mathematics - This term we will be looking at numbers, counting one to five and using number language in play (eg counting the cups in the home corner)

We will encourage the children to touch count when counting objects to help them recognise objects in set groups. We will be looking at numerals and singing lots of number rhymes. We will also explore colour, space, shape and measure by using various building materials.

Physical development

This term children will be taking part in PE, playing games, following instructions and developing our gross motor skills. We will be using a variety of equipment such as bats, balls and hoops to support hand-eye co-ordination, teamwork and balance.

Within the classroom, we explore finger gym which develops our fine motor skills, with activities such as threading, using small blocks and mark making. Children will be taking part in tumble tots, dough disco and outdoor games such as football and using the bikes.

Understanding the World

As the seasons change we will be exploring the world around us, looking at the changes in the environment. We will be looking for mini beasts, catching leaves, exploring the rain and making kites to fly in the wind.

We will also be learning about different animals such as hedgehogs and owls.

Throughout the term we will be celebrating various traditions such as Christmas and bonfire night.

During the Autumn months could parents please provide a coat due to going outside every day. Please ensure your child has suitable

footwear and clothing and is

labelled with their name.
