Science

Across the Autumn Term, we will have two different scientific topics to investigate. Understanding Bodies, where children will look at nutrition, diet and the different skeletons that living things have. Light and Shadows, will explore light sources, how light travels and how shadows are created.





Black History Project

Our Black History project will focus on Martin Luther King Jr. Children will learn why he is a significant person in World History and how he helped change the world.

In Year 3 we will be reading and exploring a range of texts including: The True Story of the Three Little Pigs, Aesop's Fables, UG and Stone Age

The children will learn to write for a range of different purposes and audiences.

History & Geography

In Geography we will be exploring our local area of Wolverhampton. We will develop our map skills and understand the geographical features within and around St Jude's. We will then move on to History where we will be exploring what life was like in the Stone Age, looking at diet, jobs, homes, tools and Stone Age art.

Mathematics

During our Mathematics lessons we are going to build on our calculation skills, learning different written methods. We will explore, in greater depth fractions, money, shape, measures, data handling and reading and telling the time. Children will be encouraged to apply their knowledge to a range of problems and solve reasoning style questions.

Well-Being



In Well-Being this term the children will be identifying their goals for the year and understanding how to express their feelings and worries.



Computing

We will begin our Autumn term developing our coding skills by designing and creating an interactive scene.

We will then move on to Online Safety in Autumn 2.

Before ending with a module on Spreadsheets.

Within Religious Education we will develop children's knowledge and understanding of the Creation Story and what God's image for the world was. Before moving on to what it is like to be a follower of God in Autumn 2.

Art and DT

For our Art topic we will be getting our inspiration from Andy Warhol's creative pop art designs. In DT we will be using our cooking skills to design and bake cookies!


