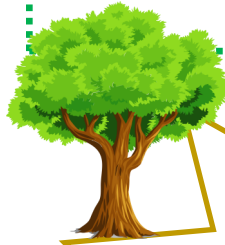

Please ensure your child has suitable footwear and clothing which is labelled with their name.

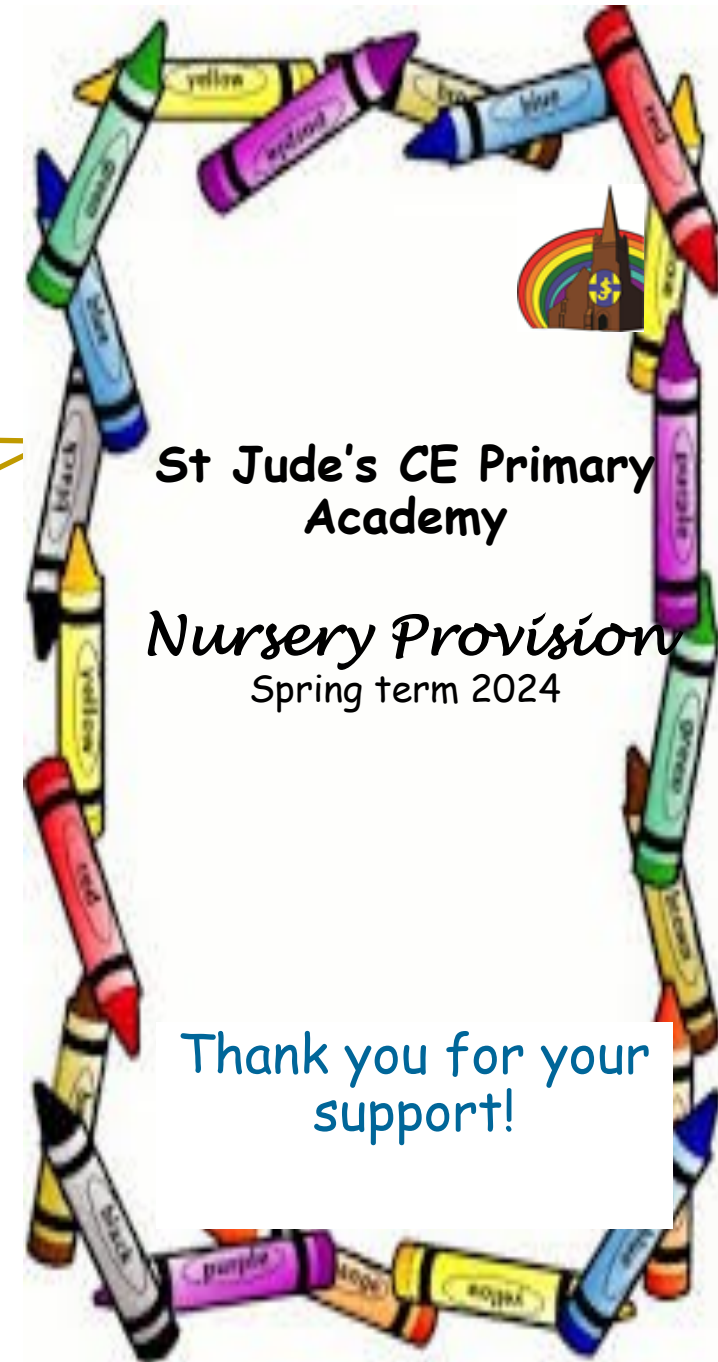
Nursery will be going to Forest schools on welly Wednesday Please ensure your child is dressed appropriately

Curriculum

We want to take this opportunity to welcome back our older members of Nursery and the children who have recently joined us.

For the next couple of weeks we will be settling your child back into their daily school routine. We will be supporting the children with:



- ⇒ using equipment safely;
- ⇒ Sharing;
- ⇒ taking turns;
- ⇒ encouraging friendships;
- ⇒ Demonstrating Positive behaviour

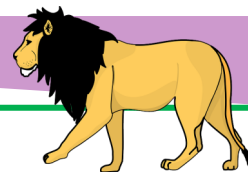


Within the setting, we will be celebrating children's achievements at home as well as school. We look forward to hearing about what makes you proud of your child. In Nursery, we will be celebrating children's success through 'star of the week', praise and stickers.



We have a 'wow board' within Nursery and if your child has done something amazing at home or at school we will then write it down and display it on our wow board. We will also record your child's achievement in their learning journal showing their development, progress and achievements.

Parents/careers are encouraged and welcomed to fill out wow stars.



Communication & Language

Within the nursery provision, we will be supporting your child to create friendships, follow instructions and routines and share with others. We will encourage children to use a wide range of vocabulary and sing a large repertoire of songs/ nursery rhymes. We have also started to introduce a Makaton sign each week. Makaton uses signs and symbols to help children communicate. It is designed to support the development of spoken language.

We will support the children to demonstrate an understanding in many ways such as responding to and asking questions. Children will be encouraged to express their feelings in different ways and will be supported by adults asking a variety of questions. We will look at children understanding a question or instruction that has two parts such as: "Get your coat and wait at the door."

Some of the topics we will be looking at:

- ⇒ Traditional tales
- ⇒ Valentines day
- ⇒ Chinese New year
- ⇒ Fairy tales



Literacy

Within the setting we will be looking at different books supporting our topic 'traditional tales and 'fairy tales'. We will be encouraging your child to use books appropriately by holding them the correct way or turning individual pages. Understanding print has meaning and identifying the names of different parts of a book. Each day we encourage your child to share their favourite books with their friends to engage in conversations about stories. Children will be encouraged to mark -make in different ways by using chalking, paint, water and sand.

Expressive arts and design

In Nursery, we will be taking part in simple pretend play, develop stories using small world equipment, We will be exploring different materials and textures. This will allow the children to copy adults' behaviour like make a cup of tea or the dinner. Explore textures such as soft, smooth and rough. In addition we will explore colour and colour mixing, begin to develop stories using small world equipment like animals and dolls houses.

Physical Development

This term children will be taking part in PE each week on a Monday. Children will take part in different activities and be shown different skills which will be developed within the term.

In the classroom, there is a finger gym area which is changed daily. Children will be taking part in tumble tots, dough disco and yoga. Children will be supported when going to the toilet and encouraged to help with their own self care, such as pulling their own trousers up or putting their own coat on and zipping it up.

Understanding the World

We will be exploring changes in various materials and exploring the season Spring by taking part in nature walks. We will be looking at the changes in the Spring and develop the children's knowledge around different springtime animals. We will encourage children to use all their senses in hands-on exploration of natural materials.

We will also be using a wide range of technology such as Fizz books, Bee-Bots, cameras and iPads. Children will be supported to use this equipment to support their own learning and development. This term we will be exploring different celebrations such as Chinese New Year and Valentine's Day.



Mathematics

This term, we will be making comparisons between objects relating to size, length, weight and capacity. Link numerals and amounts: for example, showing the right amount of objects to match the numeral, up to five.
