Summer term fun

During the summer term, we will be exploring a variety of exciting topics, We will be learning about floating and sinking and carrying out science experiments.

This will be followed by our topic of People who help us where we will read ' But I don't want a haircut,' 'The Refuse Trucks,' and 'I'm the bus driver.'

Following our half term break we will be talking about the seaside. If we have been to the seaside and what we see there.

Communication, Language and Literacy

This term, we will be focusing on our mark making skills , writing, forming our letters, writing our names and talking about our work. We will be joining in with stories, reading a range of stories, poems and songs. We will be learning and understanding the five key concepts about print: print has meaning, print can have different purposes, we read English text from left to right and from top to bottom, the names of the different parts of a book and page sequencing.

<u>Mathematics</u>

This term, we will be looking at numbers by going on number hunts, ordering, singing, counting, estimating and problem solving. We will explore space, shape and measure by using money at the hair salon, building with blocks and learning the names of shapes. We will be developing fast recognition of up to 3 objects, understand cardinal principle (that the last number reached when counting a small set of objects tells you how many there are in total).

Understanding the World

We celebrate upcoming celebrations such as Fathers' day, St George's Day and we will have a pirate party. We will be exploring changes in the environment, talking about the weather and what we can see in our nature area.

We will also be using a wide range of technology such as fizz books, bee bots, laptops, iPads and the interactive whiteboard.

Physical development

During this term, we will participate in sports day, taking turns, joining in with races, completing assault courses and following instructions.

We will continue to develop our fine motor skills through a range of finger gym activities such as threading, using tweezers and manipulating playdough.

Expressive Art and Design

We will be painting pictures of people who help us and the seaside. Draw pictures with increasing detail and complexity. Use drawings to represent movement and loud noises.

<u>PSED</u>

We want the children to be increasingly independent in meeting their own care needs, e.g. brushing teeth, using the toilet, washing and drying their hands thoroughly.
