St Jude's CE Primary Academy Reception Summer Term 2024



Welcome to Summer Term in Reception.

This term, we will be building on our learning from the Spring Term.

We will continue to have lots of fun exploring our inside and outside environment including identifying changes within the seasons.

We will build on our skills and explore new activities and experiences. At the end of the term we will be getting the children ready for their transition into Year I and we will celebrate all of their achievements this year.

In Literacy this term, we will be reading a variety of stories, such as 'One Night in the Zoo, 'We're Going On a Lion Hunt', 'The Rainbow Fish', 'Commotion in the Ocean' and many more.

The children will have the opportunity to retell the stories, write labels, letters and begin to build simple sentences into their own stories. We will also look at a range of other stories and nursery rhymes across the term.

In Maths, we will be investigating number by exploring addition and subtraction, looking at sharing and we will look at doubling and halving. In our shape, space and measure work, we will be finding out about shapes and patterns all around us. We will also be using the measurement of capacity and continuing to explore positional language.

For our Understanding the World focus, we will be looking at People Who Help Us.
Then we will be going on journeys around the world where we will look at animals in Africa as well as going 'Under the Sea'.



In Physical Development, we will be having a 'Mini Athletics Tournament' and we will be exploring different team games that we can play. The children will be able to practise their fine motor skills through a range of activities during the day.

In PSED, we will be looking at how to keep healthy. We will explore the importance of a balanced diet and how exercise is vital.

In Worship, we will be listening to Bible stories and saying our daily Reception prayers. We will also be exploring the creation story and looking at what makes something special.
