

Our journey through Summer term looks very exciting in Year 1!

Literacy

As part of Literacy this term we will be building on our writing skills to produce a range of different sentence types to suit different genres of writing, including stories and poetry. We will be looking at stories including 'Tad' and 'Frogs'. We will also continue to practise our phonics to prepare us for our phonics screening in June.

Numeracy

During Numeracy this term we will continue to read and write numbers in numerals and in words. We will develop our knowledge of place value and solve addition and subtraction calculations. We will continue to think about the 2, 5 and 10 times tables and use this to help us solve multiplication and division problems. We will practise our number bonds regularly so that we can recite them quickly and confidently. We will also be looking at capacity, weight and time.



Topic

This term in history we will be looking what it was like for our grandparents as children- asking questions about their school days and how things have changed over time.

As part of geography we will be exploring animals around the world and why different animals are suited to where they live. We will be finding out about the seven continents and the five different oceans around the world.



Science

During Science this term we will be learning about Marvellous Materials. We will be exploring different properties of materials and why they are best suited for different objects. We will also be looking at magnetic and non-magnetic materials and sorting objects by their properties.



Art

During Art this term we will be looking at Henri Matisse.

We will be using a range of materials to develop our techniques using texture, colour, form and space.



R.E

During R.E this term we will be looking at Sikhism and their holy building called the Gurdwara. We will be thinking about why this is a special place for Sikhs, as well as looking at the important features of the building. We will also be thinking about the meaning of creation and recalling the Christian creation story.



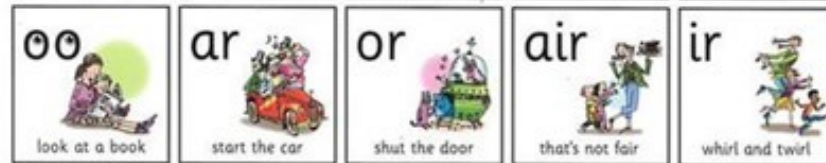
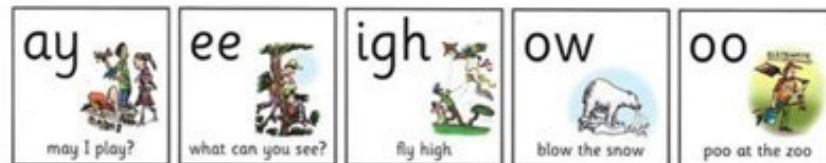
Computing

We will be learning computer skills to produce a sequence of movements. We will also be creating an algorithm for a sequence of movements.

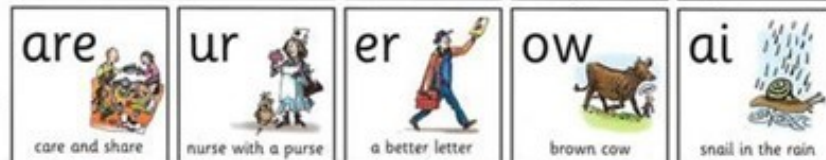
