Your child will have come home with a wordless book today. Please look at this book with your child and discuss the pictures and what they think is happening in the story and what might happen next. Children will begin to bring home worded books once our phonic sessions have begun and children are able to blend sounds to read words.

At the start of each day, children are welcomed to the carpet and will take part in a song for that day. The list of these songs are below, you can sing these songs with your children at home if you would like.

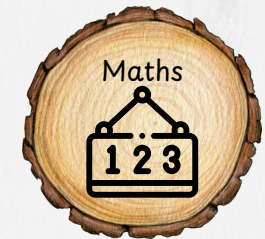
Monday - Twinkle Twinkle Little Star

Matching objects, comparing amounts. identifying sets. Activities to support the development of oracy through direct, purposeful questioning.

We will have the opportunity to go into our Forest School, to create some art out of nature and take part in some team building activities.

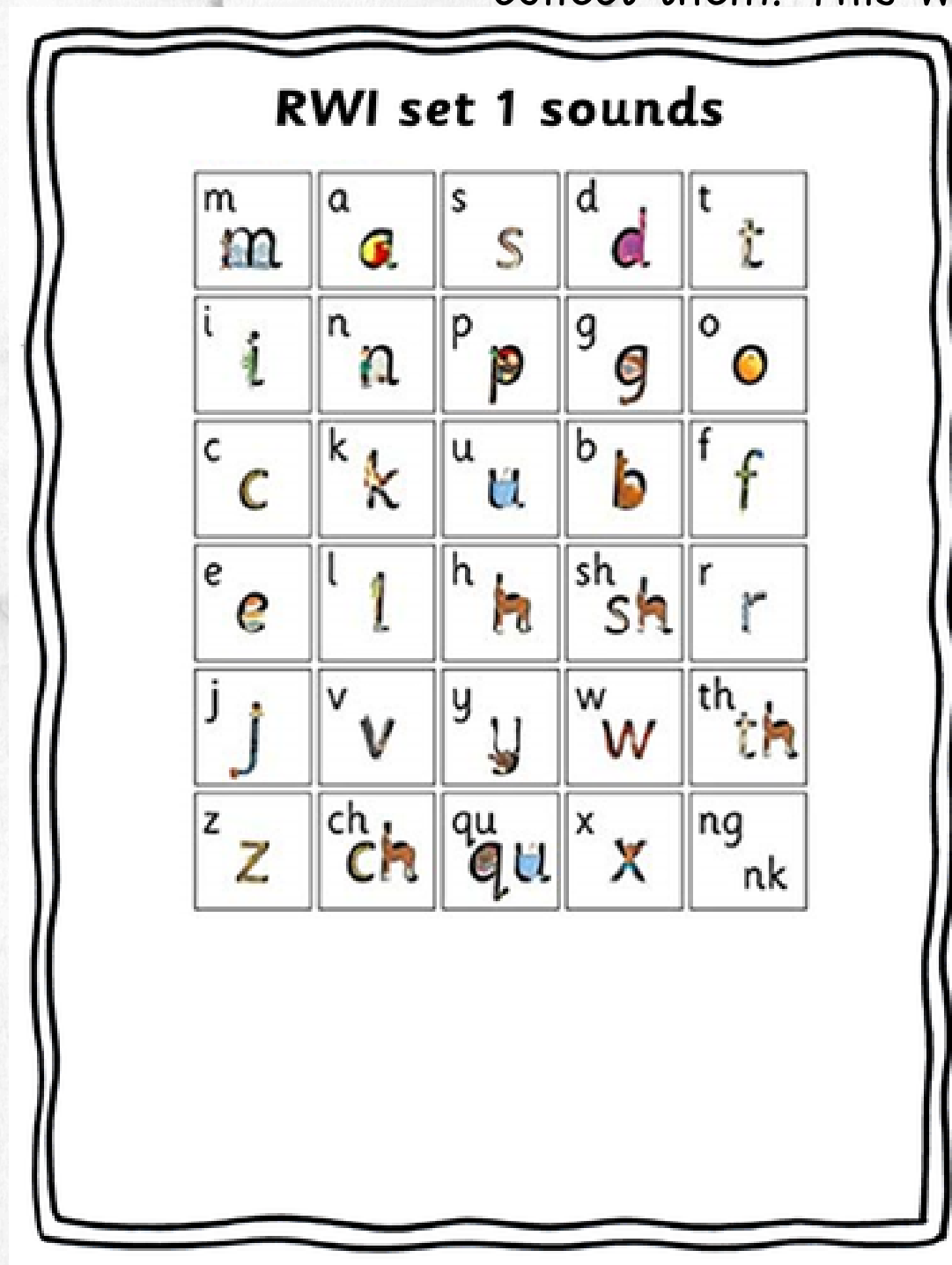
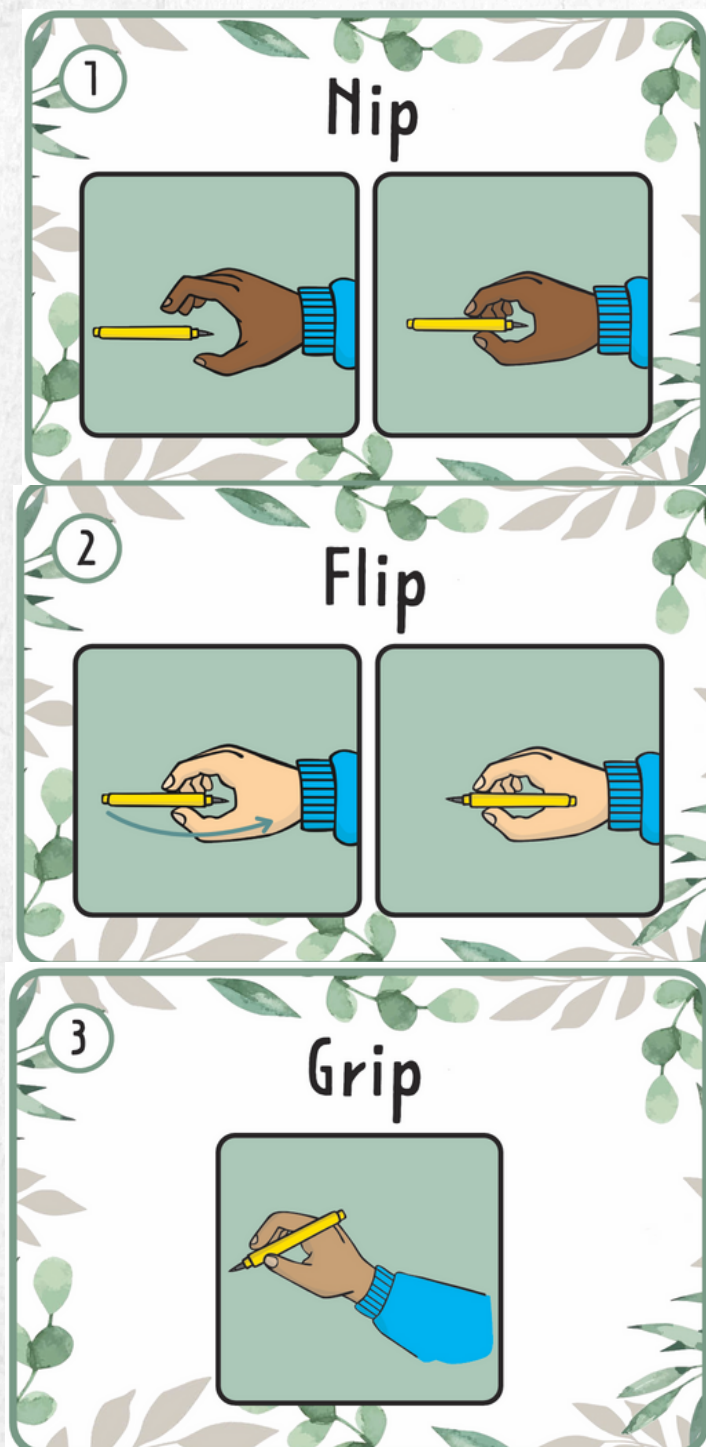
For children to get the best out of these activities we would appreciate if you could send in wellies and a spare pair of dry clothes to change into.
