## Geography

During Geography this term we will be developing our map skills and our knowledge of the world. We will be looking at where we live in Wolverhampton As part of the lessons we will be looking at human and physical geographical features, as well as using a map for orienteering.



### <u>History</u>

As part of History this term we will be discussing what an explorer is and finding out about the famous explorers Christopher Columbus, Neil Armstrong and Tim Peake. We will be looking at how they travelled, where they travelled and what they achieved. We will also be finding out about the Wright brothers and their invention of the first plane to take flight.



# History Project

During History this term we will be discussing what makes a good role model and we will share who our role model is. We will then learn facts about Mary Seacole. By the end of this term we will know who Mary Seacole was and why she is famous.



During Literacy this term we will read a range of books such as Beegu, The Way Back Home and Billy and the Beast. We will learn how to spell words correctly and how to make our writing interesting. We will have daily phonic sessions to help develop our reading so that we can read a range of books independently.

#### Science

During Science this term we will learn about the four seasons. We will observe and discuss the changes that happen during each season. We will compare how we spend our days in the summer to how we spend our days in the winter.



# RE

During R.E this term we will learn about how to communicate with God through prayer. We will also focus on the Nativity story and think about why Christians celebrate Christmas.






### <u>Wellbeing</u>

During Well-Being this term we are going to be looking at 'Being Me in My World' which looks at being safe and feelings in different situations. We will then go on to look at 'Celebrating Difference' which looks at how we are the same and different to each other and bullying.



#### Numeracy

During Numeracy this term we will learn how to read and write numbers in numerals and in words. We will learn how to use our number line to solve addition and subtraction calculations and find missing numbers. We will practise our number bonds regularly so that we can recite them quickly and confidently.




#### Art & D.T

During Art this term we will be completing a project in 3D Art. This will include sculpting using clay to create a 3D acom and observational drawings to show pattern and texture. In the Autumn term, Year pupils will explore simple mechanisms by learning how sliders and levers create movement. They will design and make their own moving picture, using these mechanisms to bring their ideas to life.



We will learn about online safety by understanding how to use the internet responsibly and who to talk to if something makes them feel uncomfortable. They are also exploring pictograms, using simple charts to represent data.
