Numeracy

In Numeracy, we will be working on all aspects of mathematics, including number, addition and subtraction, multiplication and division and fractions. It is important that your child continues to practise recalling multiplication facts as they must know these by the end of this year.

<u>History</u>

In History, children will be learning about the Industrial Revolution. Children will learn about the different events that occurred during the Industrial Revolution and the impact this period of time had on England, and our local area. Children will also look at how life for children was different to the lives they live

Geography

Within Geography, we will be exploring our local area in more detail. Children will use skills such as mapping, digital mapping and focus upon human and physical features of our local area. Children will use technology to explore Wolverhampton in more detail.

Science

In our Science topic Year 4 will be studying States of Matter. We will be investigating solids, liquids and gases. Children will be learning how they can change the state of water and the water cycle.


In addition to this, Living things, including humans, will be covered. Areas such as the human digestive system, food chains and types of teeth will be explored in detail.





