


This is our learning journey for the Spring term in Year 2.

Literacy

Spring 2026

Here are just a few of the books we will be exploring this term. Children will complete a range of learning opportunities to develop their creative writing and build on their reading comprehension skills. Children will also be focusing on their spelling, grammar and punctuation skills.



Science

Children will be exploring materials and their properties. They will understand how materials are suitable for different uses and learn scientific language to develop their knowledge. Children will investigate a range of scenarios where they need to apply their scientific learning.



Geography and History

This term in Geography, children will be learning all about seaside towns. They will locate different oceans and seas around the world and think about how coasts are shaped differently and have different uses. In History, children will be looking at significant females in history and how these people shaped life today.



R.E

This term we will look at what Christians believe that God is like by looking at some stories and what Christians do in church. We will then be looking at why Easter is important to Christians and what happened in the Easter story.

Music

The children will continue to develop and learn new skills in Music taught by a specialist teacher. They will be reading and composing their own music which they will play on a variety of instruments. We will encourage the children to develop their confidence when performing to an audience.




Computing

Numeracy


In Numeracy, the children will be exploring the relationships between numbers and the four operations. Children will be developing their knowledge of problem-solving and reasoning. We will be covering place value, measurement, addition and subtraction, multiplication and division, statistics and money.



Art and DT

In Art, the focus artist is Wassily Kandinsky. Children will explore his abstract art and consider how music inspired his pieces. In DT, children will be preparing their own fruit and vegetables. They will look at products that already exist and review their own.




